William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not timely filed. MCR 7.204(A). The claim of appeal was not filed within 21 days after entry of the final order appealed from, the judgment of divorce entered on April 18, 2013, or within 21 days after entry of the order denying the motion to amend or modify the divorce judgment on May 13, 2013. MCR 7.204(A)(1). The motion for reconsideration of the order denying the motion to modify or amend the divorce judgment did not extend the time for filing the claim of appeal under MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b) because it was not filed within the initial 21-day period as required by MCR 7.204(A)(2)(e). At this time, plaintiff-appellant may seek to appeal only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
