David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the order dated September 18, 2013 and entered in the circuit court register of actions on September 19, 2013 is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because, as an order merely declining to set aside a default, it is not an order disposing of any claim in this case. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the September 19, 2013 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
