Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The appellant's motion to remand is STRICKEN for failure to conform to the requirements of MCR 7.211(A). The motion does not conform because the proof of service of the motion does not indicate the date of service as required under MCR 2.104(A). The motion to remand that was filed on March 27, 2015, was not accompanied by a proof of service as required under MCR 7.211(A)(5), appellant's counsel failed to timely respond to the Clerk's March 30, 2015, letter notifying counsel of the deficiency in the filing, and the proof of service that was eventually filed on April 22, 2015, fails to indicate the date that the motion to remand was served as required under MCR 2.104(A).

The Clerk of the Court shall place this case on the involuntary dismissal docket if no appellant's brief or proper motion to remand is filed within 14 days after the date this order is entered.
