
The Court orders that the motion to remand is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the necessity of a remand at this time, particularly because counsel's performance for purposes of an ineffective assistance of counsel claim is evaluated under an objective standard of reasonableness. *People v Trakhtenberg*, 493 Mich 38, 51; 826 NW2d 136 (2012). Thus, there does not appear to be a need for a remand to develop a factual record as to trial counsel's subjective reasons for failing to object as to the matters discussed in the motion.
