By order entered on July 25, 2014, the Court granted the motion by Court Reporter Annette Seguin (R 2184) to extend the time to file the transcript 91 days to October 29, 2014. On October 22, 2014, Ms. Seguin filed a second motion to extend the time in which to file the transcript 91 days to January 29, 2015. The Court's order of October 29, 2014, indicated in part that further discipline pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f) could result if Ms. Seguin failed to file transcript by January 29, 2015. The transcript has not been filed. Instead, Ms. Seguin has filed a third motion to extend the time to file the transcript, which was due on July 29, 2014, for an additional 91 days.

The Court orders that the motion for a third extension of time to file the transcript is DENIED. In lieu of ordering the court reporter to show cause, the Court further orders that Court Reporter Seguin is ASSESSED COSTS in the amount of \$200 for failing to file the transcript by January 29, 2015. The costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court within 21 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

If a copy of the notice of filing the transcript has not been filed with the Clerk's Office of the Court of Appeals on or before March 5, 2015, the court reporter may be subject to discipline pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), specifically including the issuance of an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until all of the reporter's transcripts ordered for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk.
