Michael J. Riordan, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion for reconsideration is GRANTED ONLY TO THE EXTENT that defendant-appellant is allowed an additional 14 days from the date this order is entered to file a pro se supplemental brief that raises the claim of ineffective assistance of counsel identified in the pro se motion to remand initially received on January 27, 2015. Administrative Order 2004-6, Standard 4 allows the filing of a pro se motion only if it is filed along with a pro se supplemental brief and defendant-appellant's claim of ineffective assistance of counsel is not effectively raised on appeal unless it is identified as an issue raised in a supplemental brief. If a supplemental brief is not filed within the time allotted, the pro se motion to remand shall be returned.
