
The Court orders that the motion to remand is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the necessity of a remand at this time. Particularly, the defense has not provided indication of appropriate preliminary investigation to warrant a remand where it provides no indication of appellate defense counsel making any effort to locate and interview the alleged hotel resident employee who defendant claims could have provided exculpatory testimony. We note that defendant may file a motion for reconsideration supported by an appropriate affidavit within 21 days of the date of this order, MCR 7.215(I)(1), if the defense promptly undertakes such appropriate preliminary investigation and finds that there is an actual witness who states that she would have provided such exculpatory testimony.
