By order entered on November 26, 2014, the Court granted the motion by Court Reporter Teria Carrington (R 6619) to extend the time to file the transcript 62 days to January 12, 2015, but directed the Clerk to submit the matter for disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f) if the transcript was not filed by January 12, 2015. On January 12, 2015, Ms. Carrington filed a notice of filing seven volumes of the transcript. On January 15, 2015, Ms. Carrington filed a motion seeking an additional 18 days in which to file the remaining transcript. On January 16, 2015, Ms. Carrington filed a notice of filing seven additional volumes of the transcript and on January 23, 2015, Ms. Carrington filed a notice of filing one volume of the transcript.

The Court orders that the motion to extend the time to file the remaining two volumes of the transcript is GRANTED. The time for Court Reporter Teria Carrington (R 6619) to file the transcript is extended to January 30, 2015. In lieu of ordering the court reporter to show cause, the Court further orders that Court Reporter Carrington is ASSESSED COSTS in the amount of \$100 for failing to file the transcript by January 12, 2015. The costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court within 21 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

If a copy of the notice of filing the transcript has not been filed with the Clerk's Office of the Court of Appeals on or before January 30, 2015, the court reporter may be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), which could include the assessment of costs, issuance of an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until all of the reporter's overdue transcripts ordered for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk, and/or issuance of an order to show cause why the reporter is not in contempt of this Court.
