The Court orders that the motion to remand is DENIED because it is not supported by an affidavit or offer of proof regarding facts to be established at an evidentiary hearing on remand as required by MCR 7.211(C)(1)(a). Further, the issues raised by defendant appear to be matters that may be reviewed from the existing record. We note that, contrary to defendant's indication, there is no automatic entitlement to a remand for an evidentiary hearing whenever a defendant raises a claim of ineffective assistance of counsel. Rather, whether to grant a motion to remand is entrusted to this Court's discretion. *People v Hernandez*, 443 Mich 1, 21; 503 NW2d 629 (1993).
