

Court reporter Keva M. Jackson (R 5964) has failed to file the transcript as required under MCR 7.210(B)(3)(b)(iv) pursuant to this Court's February 18, 2015, order granting the reporter's motion to extend time to file the transcript an additional 60 days to March 23, 2015. The court reporter also failed to respond to the Clerk's notice that the transcript was overdue and that the appeal was eligible for involuntary dismissal for appellant's failure to secure the timely filing of the transcript, and failed to respond to appellant's motion to order the court reporter to show cause.

In lieu of ordering the court reporter to show cause, the Court, pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), orders that Court Reporter Keva M. Jackson (R 5964) is ASSESSED COSTS in the amount of \$250 as a sanction for her failure to comply with her duties under MCR 7.210(B)(3). The costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court within 21 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

If the notice of filing is not filed by May 13, 2015, the court reporter may be subject to further disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), which could include the assessment of additional costs, issuance of an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until all of the reporter's overdue transcripts ordered for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk, and/or issuance of an order to show cause why the reporter is not in contempt of this Court.


