The outstanding transcripts were due from Court Reporter Jacquetta M. Smith (R 6472) on February 17, 2015 and February 24, 2015. By order issued on March 18, 2015, this Court extended the time for filing the transcripts to May 5, 2015, and warned that the matter may be submitted for disciplinary action if the transcripts were not filed by that date. Outstanding transcripts have yet to be filed and the reporter has not filed a second motion for extension of time.

In lieu of ordering the court reporter to show cause, the Court, on its own motion, pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), orders that Court Reporter Jacquetta M. Smith (R 6472) is ASSESSED COSTS of \$200 as a sanction for her failure to file the transcripts by the extended time allotted. The costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court within 21 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

The Court further orders that reporter Smith shall file a copy of the notice of filing the remaining transcripts within 21 days of the date of this order, or the court reporter may be subject to further disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), including the assessment of additional costs or issuance of an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until the outstanding transcripts have been filed with the trial court clerk.
