Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), the Court orders that in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, the motion to remand, to the extent it seeks a remand for resentencing, is GRANTED. Since it does not appear that there was ever full compliance with MCR 6.005(D), on remand the trial court shall follow the procedure outlined in this rule if defendant elects to waive counsel. If the trial court again elects to impose a sentence that is inconsistent with the plea agreement, it must follow the procedure outlined in *People v Cobbs*, 443 Mich 276; 505 NW2d 208 (1993). This order has immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2).

The motion to remand, to the extent it seeks a remand for plea withdrawal, is DENIED without prejudice to defendant seeking relief from judgment in accordance with MCR 6.502.
