The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion to seal is GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that the motion for stay pending appeal and brief in support of that motion are sealed. We find good cause to seal those items based on appellant's need to comply with the Michigan Public Service Commission's protective order as to confidential information that is necessarily discussed in those items. Further, we determine that there are no less restrictive means to adequately and effectively protect the interest asserted. MCR 7.211(C)(9)(e). However, appellant has not presented any appropriate basis to seal the entire Court of Appeals file.

The Clerk shall disclose or provide copies of any order or opinion entered in this appeal, MCR 8.119(I)(5); MCR 7.211(C)(9)(c), but sealed pleadings or other contents of the file shall not be disclosed or made available for public viewing. The case docket shall not be blocked on the Court's website.

The Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this order to the Clerk of the Supreme Court and to the State Court Administrative Office. MCR 8.119(I)(7); MCR 7.211(C)(9)(c).

O'Connell, P.J., would DENY the motion to seal.
