

Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:


The Court orders that the motion to hold a decision on the delayed application for leave to appeal in abeyance is GRANTED IN PART. The delayed application shall initially be held in abeyance to allow defendant to file a motion for appropriate postjudgment relief in the trial court by May 26, 2015, i.e., within the six-month period allowed by MCR 6.310(C) and MCR 6.429(B)(3). If defendant files such a motion in the trial court she shall provide this Court with a copy of the motion within seven days of its filing in the trial court, schedule the motion for hearing within 28 days of filing, and order the transcript of any hearings on the motion within seven days of the conclusion of any such hearings. Further, defendant shall provide this Court with a copy of the request for any such transcripts within seven days after making the request. If such a motion is filed in the trial court and these requirements are substantially met as determined by this Court's Clerk's Office, the delayed application will be held in abeyance until the latter of 21 days after the trial court enters a written order completely disposing of the motion or the court reporter files the transcript of any hearings on the motion. Defendant shall be allowed to file a supplemental brief to her application for leave to appeal raising any additional issues she deems appropriate within that 21-day period without further order of this Court. If defendant files such a supplemental brief, plaintiff may file an answer in response within 21 days of service of the supplemental brief. Thereafter, the delayed application, including the supplemental brief, shall be submitted to a panel of this Court for a decision.
