The Court orders that the motion to extend time to file transcripts is DENIED. Certain outstanding transcripts were due to be produced by Court Reporter Regenia Veasy (R 2350) on June 9, 2015, but have not been filed. Instead, Ms. Veasy has filed a motion seeking an additional 93 days for production of those transcripts and 83 days for the production of the remaining transcripts due on June 19, 2015.

In lieu of ordering the court reporter to show cause, the Court, on its own motion, pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), orders that Reporter Veasy is BARRED from recording any proceedings in any court of this state until all the overdue transcripts ordered from Ms. Veasy for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk.
