Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because, like with the prior claim of appeal in Court of Appeals Docket Number 324722, it was not filed within 21 days of entry of the October 28, 2014 order deciding the motion for postjudgment relief. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b). The time limit for filing an appeal of right is jurisdictional. MCR 7.204(A). Again, MCR 7.205(G)(1) regards the filing of a delayed application for leave to appeal and does not authorize the filing of a late claim of appeal. In this regard, a delayed application for leave to appeal is a distinct form of initiating a case in this Court from a claim of appeal. The basic filing requirements for an application or delayed application for leave to appeal are set forth in MCR 7.205(B). Appellant may seek to appeal the October 6, 2014 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal that order by April 28, 2015, i.e., six months after the October 28, 2014 order deciding the motion for postjudgment relief. See MCR 7.205(G)(3)(b).
