Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The complaint for superintending control and motion for immediate consideration are DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because an appeal from the March 12, 2015 order is available. MCR 3.302(D)(2). As a result, plaintiff may challenge the order in question by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205. See MCR 7.203(B)(5). Any appeal from an order terminating parental rights must be filed within 63 days of entry of the order of termination. MCR 7.205(G)(6); MCR 3.993(C)(2).
