In lieu of granting the motion for reconsideration, the Court orders, on its own motion, that defendant-appellant's claim of appeal is treated as an application for leave to appeal and is GRANTED. See MCR 7.205(E)(2); *In re Beatrice Rottenberg Trust*, 300 Mich App 339, 354; 833 NW2d 384 (2013). This appeal is limited to whether the Midland Circuit Court erred by granting plaintiff-appellee's motion for change of domicile in its opinion and order of April 14, 2015.

On its own motion, the Court orders that this appeal is EXPEDITED. Defendant-appellant's brief is due no later than 35 days from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. Plaintiff-appellee's brief is due no later than 21 days after service of defendant-appellant's brief. No extensions of time will be allowed for filing of the briefs except by order of the Court.


The Clerk is directed to place this case on the next available case call after the expiration of the time to file plaintiff-appellee's brief.
