The Court orders that appellee's motion to dismiss this appeal for lack of jurisdiction is GRANTED because the April 27, 2015 order is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of appellee's claims with regard to its request for abatement of an alleged nuisance. Further, the April 27, 2015 order is plainly not a final order under the special definitions in MCR 7.202(6)(a)(ii)-(v). Thus, the claim of appeal is DISMISSED.

Appellant's motion for stay is DENIED as moot.

At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the April 27, 2015 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G). We note that appellant may also file an attendant motion for stay simultaneously with, or subsequent to, filing such a delayed application for leave to appeal.
