Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the June 15, 2015 decision of the Crime Victim Services Commission is not appealable of right. Rather, a claimant wishing to appeal a decision of the Crime Victim Services Commission to this Court must file an application or delayed application for leave to appeal. See MCL 18.358. Accordingly, appellant may seek to appeal the June 15, 2015 decision by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal within the six-month period allowed by MCR 7.205(G)(3). See *Calloway-Gaines v Crime Victim Services Comm*, 463 Mich 341; 616 NW2d 674 (2000).

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.
