Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, the Court REMANDS this matter to the trial court for a determination of the factual basis for the court costs imposed, unless the court has already made such a determination. *People v Konopka*, 309 Mich App 345; 869 NW2d 651 (2015).

This Court further orders that on remand, the trial court correct the presentence investigation report to the extent that it erroneously identifies defendant's sentence guidelines or offense variable (OV) 14 score. The corrected report shall be forwarded to the Department of Corrections within 28 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. In all other aspects, the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented. This order has immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2).

We do not retain jurisdiction.
