Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the claim of appeal was not timely filed with respect to the November 4, 2015, order appealed from, MCR 7.204(A)(1), and because the November 4, 2015, order is not a final order that is appealable by right under MCR 3.993(A). MCR 7.203(A). The November 4, 2015, order is not appealable by right under MCR 3.993(A)(1) because it is not an **order of disposition** removing a minor from the home. See *In re McCarrick/Lamoreaux Minors*, 307 Mich App 436; 861 NW2d 303 (2014). The appeal from the November 4, 2015, order must come by application for leave to appeal. See MCR 3.993(B).
