MEMORANDUM.

Respondent appeals as of right from the family court order terminating his parental rights to the minor child under MCL 712A.19b(3)(b)(i), (g), (j) and (k)(iii).¹ We affirm.

The family court did not clearly err in finding that the statutory grounds for termination were established by clear and convincing evidence. See MCR 5.974(I); *In re Miller*, 433 Mich

¹ The order terminating respondent's parental rights cites MCL 712A.19b(3)(k) as a basis for terminating respondent's parental rights, but does not articulate the applicable subsection of section (k). On the record, however, the trial court specified that the basis for termination under section (k) was subsection (iii).

331, 337; 445 NW2d 161 (1989).
