MEMORANDUM.

Respondents appeal as of right from an order terminating their parental rights to the minor children under MCL 712A.19b(3)(c)(i) and (g).¹ We affirm. This case is being decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(E).

The family court did not clearly err in finding that the statutory grounds for termination were established by clear and convincing evidence. *In re Trejo Minors*, 462 Mich 341, 356-357; 612 NW2d 407 (2000).
