The Court orders that the motion to dismiss the claim of appeal in this case is GRANTED because the October 23, 2012 order appealed from is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Particularly, that order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of any claims or adjudicate any rights and liabilities of the parties.


On the Court's own motion, the claim of cross appeal is also DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. In relevant part, MCR 7.207(A)(1) allows an appellee to file a cross appeal when an appeal of right is filed. Because appellants do not have an actual appeal of right in this appeal appellee was not entitled to file a claim of cross appeal based on appellants' improper filing of a purported appeal of right.
