David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the order denying appellant's motion for reconsideration dated July 9, 2012 and entered in the circuit court register of actions July 12, 2012 is plainly not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Further, the underlying May 29, 2012 order requiring a non-party insurance company to pay an insurance bond is also plainly not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal either the May 29, 2012 order or the July 12, 2012 order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
