Christopher M. Murray, Judge, acting under MCR 7.217(D)(1) and MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:


The motion to reinstate the appeal and motion to remand to the Tax Tribunal are GRANTED. The appeal is REINSTATED and the matter is REMANDED to the Tax Tribunal to allow appellant to move for entry of the parties' consent judgment. If a consent judgment is entered, appellant shall promptly seek dismissal of the appeal pursuant to MCR 7.218(A) or (B). If a consent judgment is not entered, appellant's brief is due within 21 days after the conclusion of the proceedings on remand. The costs assessed by the Court's order of February 6, 2013, are REAFFIRMED and shall be paid within 14 days after the Clerk's certification of this order.
