
In lieu of granting leave to appeal, the Court orders that this case is REMANDED to the circuit court with regard to Issues I and IV in the delayed application for leave to appeal. As to Issue I, the circuit court shall conduct an evidentiary hearing regarding the appropriate amount of restitution and then decide whether to grant relief as to the amount of restitution awarded. *People v Gahan*, 456 Mich 264, 276; 571 NW2d 503 (1997). As to Issue IV, the trial court shall cause a corrected presentence report to be prepared and forwarded to the Department of Corrections in accordance with MCR 6.425(E)(2). In all other respects the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented.
