David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the March 29, 2013 order of the circuit court on appeal from the Michigan Compensation Appellate Commission, an administrative tribunal, is not appealable as a matter of right. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the March 29, 2013 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).

The motion to waive fees is also DISMISSED as unnecessary because, as a claimant in an unemployment benefits case, appellant is not required to pay an entry fee. MCL 421.31.
