The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The complaint for superintending control is DENIED. A camera operator for Fox 2 News admittedly violated the trial court's May 22, 2013 media decorum order, which was entered consistent with Administrative Order No. 1989-1. In response to that violation, on June 3, 2013, the court entered an order prohibiting Fox 2 News' cameras from the courtroom. Contrary to plaintiff's representations, the June 3, 2013 order applies only to Fox 2 News' cameras; it does not prohibit other Fox 2 News personnel, such as reporters, from being present during trial. Plaintiff has not demonstrated that the court's order violates its First Amendment rights as addressed in *Richmond Newspapers, Inc v Virginia*, 448 US 555, 576-580; 100 S Ct 2814; 65 L Ed 2d 973 (1980), or that the circumstances justify the extraordinary remedy of superintending control. *Fieger v Cox*, 274 Mich App 449, 461; 734 NW2d 602 (2007).
