
In lieu of granting leave to appeal, the Court orders that the portion of the judgment of sentence that assesses costs in the amount of \$3000 is REVERSED and the matter is REMANDED for RESENTENCING following an evidentiary hearing where evidence is presented to establish the reasonable amount of court costs in accordance with *People v Sanders*, 296 Mich App 710; 825 NW2d 87 (2012) and *People v Cunningham*, \_\_\_ Mich App \_\_\_; \_\_\_ NW2d \_\_\_ (2013)(Docket No. 309277). The trial court may assess \$3000 costs on resentencing, provided evidence is presented to establish that this is a reasonable amount. The record on appeal does not include any evidence to establish that \$3000 is a reasonable amount. We do not retain jurisdiction.
