David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:


The claim of appeal is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction because, as to its aspects by which appellant is aggrieved, the November 19, 2013 order appealed from is not a final order as defined in MCR 7.202(6). MCR 7.203(A)(1). The provisions of the postjudgment order regarding appellee's parenting time, counseling for the parties' children, and the restriction on the interaction of the parties' children with a third party cannot be considered to affect the custody of a minor under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the November 19, 2013 order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
