
The Court orders that the motion to remand pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(1) is DENIED. While defendant-appellant has supported his motion to remand with affidavits, he has primarily challenged strategic decisions made by his trial counsel and he has not properly shown that he can overcome the presumption that his attorney exercised reasonable strategy in preparing and presenting the case at trial. Defendant-appellant has also not provided a proper offer of proof to support his claims that his attorney was biased against him, but it appears that that issue can be addressed based on the existing record. Furthermore, claims raised by defendant-appellant regarding his attorney's failure to consult with him regarding trial preparations and the conduct of the trial do not appear to prove that counsel was ineffective when counsel had the authority to handle such matters without defendant-appellant's input. *People v Carter*, 462 Mich 206, 218-219; 612 NW2d 144 (2000).
