The Court orders that the motion to remand is DENIED for failure to meet the requirements of MCR 7.211(C)(1)(a) because defendant presents no specific basis for a remand. Reasonably considered, MCR 7.211(C)(1) requires an appellant to provide specific indication of the basis for requesting a remand for either an initial decision by the trial court or development of a further factual record. Also, it is unreasonable to expect this panel to conjecture whether the case call panel might consider a remand to be warranted on some unknown basis. Moreover, a case call panel would be free to order a remand on its own initiative if it concludes that it is appropriate to do so. MCR 7.216(A)(5).
