E. Thomas Fitzgerald, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to compel the circuit court clerk to deliver a copy of the record to substitute appointed counsel and to hold the appeal in abeyance is GRANTED.

The Clerk's office of this Court is directed to return the lower court record to the circuit court within 7 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

Within 21 days of the Clerk's certification of this order, the circuit court clerk shall provide substitute appointed counsel, Michael A. Faraone, with a complete copy of the circuit court record, including a copy of the transcript, at public expense and file proof of service of the record on Mr. Faraone with this Court.


The appeal shall be held in abeyance until 35 days after the date of service of the circuit court record on substitute counsel, Michael A. Faraone, to afford Mr. Faraone an opportunity to review the record and determine whether to file a supplemental brief. If Mr. Faraone elects to file a supplemental brief, it shall be due within 35 days of the date of service of the circuit court record. If a supplemental appellant's brief is filed, the prosecutor may file a supplemental brief in response.
