**APPELLEE MICHIGAN ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION COMPANY, LLC'S MOTION
FOR ACCESS TO THE DIGITAL RECORDING OF ORAL ARGUMENT
IN ORDER TO SECURE A TRANSCRIPT**

Appellee Michigan Electric Transmission Company, LLC ("METC") by its attorneys, Dykema Gossett PLLC, pursuant to Internal Operating Procedure 7.214-3, files this Motion for Access to Digital Recording of Oral Argument in Order to Secure a Transcript ("Motion"), and in support of its Motion states:

1. Oral argument was heard on this matter on November 4, 2014. The Court's opinion was issued on December 9, 2014.
2. Pursuant to Internal Operating Procedure 7.214-3, the Court maintains an audio recording of all oral arguments for a period of one year, and an individual may request access to the audio recording by filing a Motion with this Court. If the Motion is granted, a temporary electronic link to a digital copy of the recording will be provided upon payment of a \$5.00 fee. IOP 7.214-3.
3. METC requests access to the electronic link in order to obtain a digital copy of the audio recording of the oral argument held on November 4, 2014 with respect to this matter. If this Motion is granted, METC intends to secure a transcript of the audio recording by engaging the services of a court reporter, who will prepare a transcript from the Court's digital copy of the audio recording.
4. METC makes this request because internal counsel for METC and its holding company, *ITCTransmission* was unable to attend the oral argument proceedings, and would like to review a transcript of the arguments.
5. METC also makes this request so that it may obtain a transcript of the oral arguments for use in any additional proceedings that may occur regarding this matter,

and to ensure that a record of the oral arguments is preserved after the time at which the Court's audio recording is destroyed.

WHEREFORE, Appellee METC requests that the Court GRANT its Motion for Access to the Digital Recording of the Oral Argument.
