MEMORANDUM.

Defendant pleaded nolo contendere to attempted fourth-degree criminal sexual conduct, MCL 750.92; MSA 28.287; MCL 750.520e; MSA 28.788(5), and was sentenced to two years' probation. Defendant subsequently pleaded guilty to violating the terms of his probation and was sentenced to one year's incarceration in the county jail. Defendant appeals as of right. We affirm.

Defendant's sentencing challenge is moot because defendant has fully served his minimum sentence. *People v Rutherford*, 208 Mich App 198, 204; 526 NW2d 620 (1994).

Affirmed.
