MEMORANDUM.

Respondent appeals as of right from the trial court order terminating her parental rights to her minor child under MCL 712A.19b(3)(c)(i), (g) and (j). We affirm.

Respondent argues only that the trial court erred in determining that termination of her parental rights were in the child's best interests. We disagree. Contrary to respondent's argument, the evidence did not show that termination of respondent's parental rights was clearly not in the best interests of the child. MCL 712A.19b(5); *In re Trejo*, 462 Mich 341, 356-357; 612 NW2d 407 (2000). Thus, the trial court did not err in terminating respondent's parental rights to the child.
