WHITE, P.J. (*concurring*).

I concur on the basis that plaintiff did not submit evidence countering defendant's experts' opinions that plaintiff's medical records showed degenerative changes in her cervical spine that pre-dated the October 2003 accident; that even though plaintiff may have suffered a temporary aggravation of her pre-existing cervical spondylosis, she should have reached maximum medical improvement as it related to the cervical spinal surgery and that from a functional standpoint plaintiff had returned to her functional status pre-accident; and that plaintiff's need for surgery was related to degenerative disc disease, and that any neck pain should have improved within several months after surgery.
