I concur in the result and with the majority's reasoning as to the shackling issue and as to the trial court's ruling not to allow impeachment of Nestor Bonilla based on his immigration status. I disagree with the majority in that I would find error in the limitation of the cross-examination of Detective Annette Coppock regarding offers of leniency made to another prosecution witness. However, as those questions could have been asked of the witness who defendant claims was provided leniency, I do not believe the error requires reversal.
